If you want to use this module on several stores, please purchase as many licenses as you need.

INSTALLATION

REQUIREMENT

This module has been tested and works perfectly on Prestashop from version 1.5.x to version 1.7.0.5 (latest version available at the time of writing this document). It should work smoothly on all future 1.7.0.x versions.

PROCEDURE


Let say our shop is online at : <http://www.maboutique.fr/> and that the administration is accessible at : <http://www.maboutique.fr/admin/>

Prestashop offers different methods to send a module :


- From the "Modules" page of your store's administration
- From your store's directory

SEND VIA THE ADMINISTRATION

From the "Modules" tab, click on the "Add a new module" button. The following area appears :

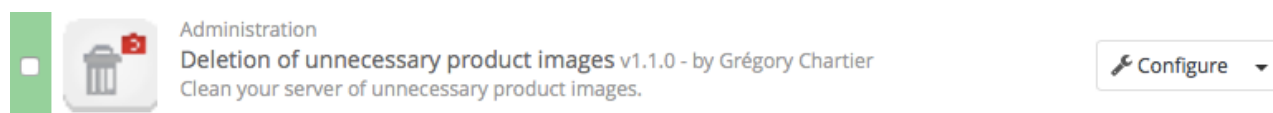

SEND VIA YOUR STORE'S DIRECTORY

Another way to send our module is to unzip the archive (obtained when you purchased our module) directly in the "modules" folder of your store.

INSTALLATION


"Deletion of unnecessary product images" now appears in the list of available modules but it's not installed on your store. In order to proceed with the installation, simply click on the "Install" button.

ADDITION OF A LANGUAGE

The module is offered in a certain number of languages. If you wish to use our module in a language that is not included in the database, you can translate the labels via the interface made for this in the back office. On the "Modules" page of your back-office, clicking on the "Configure" button on the line of our module will bring up the following settings page.

CLASSICAL OPERATION

By default, our module will browse the product image folder of your Prestashop and delete all unnecessary files. These files can be pictures that no longer match any product or image files that should not be in this folder. Our module will only delete files with the extensions png, jpg, jpeg ou gif.

- "I understand that I will delete unnecessary files": This box must be checked to avoid any manipulation errors. If it is not checked, the processing will not start.

OPTIONS

- "Delete pictures of disabled products": Check this box to include the deletion of disabled products images in the processing . This function is particularly useful for shops that keeps products after permanent stock depletion.
- "Delete pictures with old image formats": Check this box to include the types of images not used by your shop in the processing. This function is useful when your shop has undergone a redesign and the new design does not use the same types of images

SUPPORT
